The teaching philosophy is based on the classical work of Joseph Pilates, but allows for creative variations and modifications to reach a wide range of clientele, from high-energy group classes to clients with more therapeutic needs. There is always a focus on posture, form, and precision – resulting in movement that cultivates mindfulness while strengthening and aligning the body.

The ideal candidate is knowledgeable and experienced in the Pilates practice, is passionate about health and wellness, enjoys working as a part of a team, and desires to help clients achieve their full fitness potential.
